Jaume Serra Cava, Brut Nature, Spain 30

This wine has fine and small bubbles, a smooth mouthfeel and classic citrus and dough flavours.

La Montelliana Prosecco Treviso DOC, Brut, Veneto, Italy 30

Fine sparkling wine Straw-yellow colour with greenish hints, fine and rich perlage, with a typical fruity bouquet.

Platino Charmat Moscato, Semi Seco, Spain 30

The taste is sweet and fresh, with nice bubbles. It has the perfect balance between sweetness and acidity.

Asti Martini Moscato DOCG, Martini & Rossi, Piedmont, Italy 40

This sparkling wine is a great partner to fruity dessert, pastry and ice cream sweet flavoured wine with a dry taste.

Gatão Vinho Verde, Vinho Borges, Vinho Verde DOC

35

The Gatão is one of the most emblematic wines of the Vinhos Verdes Region. Young and fruity. Smooth, delicate and fresh; a fun medium-dry wine meant to be enjoyed on the hot weather of Maldives.

Germany

Weinhaus Röss Riesling Feinherb, Rheingau

38

Crisp, medium-bodied dry Riesling, with lemon, lime and apple fruit flavours, finishing with a floral lift. The perfect wine for a warm climate.

Thailand

Monsoon Valley Colombard, Siam Winery, Hua Hin Valley

40

Delicate style similar to Sauvignon Blanc. Light to medium body, crisp acidity, and complex aromas of citrus and green apple give a medium finish. Pure lemon and grapefruit flavors make it ideal for sipping on a hot day or to accompany Thai, Indian or western dishes.

Chile

Casillero del Diablo Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley

40

Straw with green hues. The aromas are attractive with hints of citrus, peaches and gooseberry. On the palate, the wine is elegant, round, and mouth-filling. The wine is also balanced with attractive, crispy acidity.

New Zealand

Overstone Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough

40

The Overstone Sauvignon Blanc has ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavors with a zingy finish and impeccable balance. A great aperitif or seafood wine made for drinking young. Serve lightly chilled.

White Wine

Italy

Le Due Torri Pinot Grigio, Grave del Friuli DOC, Venezia Giulia

40

This wine has a pale straw-yellow colour and a pleasing, light, fruity fragrance at the nose; a bouquet that is reminiscent of Kaiser pear, toasted apple seeds and sweet almonds.

France

Michel Picard Chardonnay, Burgundy

50

Pale yellow with lime hints. Complex nose of white flowers and citrus fruit aromas.

Spain

Contrapunto Albariño, Rias Baixas Galicia

50

Clear bright straw yellow with green hues that shows its youth. At the nose fresh and fruity with a touch of green fresh citrus fruits and tropical fruit aromas.

South Africa

Kleine Zalze Chenin blanc, Stellenbosch

55

Elegant and likeable with baked honey, nectarine, barley sugar and ripe apricot. Vibrant fresh acidity kicks in keeping the finish clean and dry.

Chile

Marques de Casa Concha Chardonnay, Maipo Valley

60

Super fresh, with vibrant tangerine, yellow apple and heather notes backed by nice cut on the mineral-filled finish. A deliciously unadorned style.

France

Michel Picard Chablis, Burgundy

70

Light golden yellow with green tints. Floral aromas with citrus tinges. Frank attack which develops citrus and floral aromas.

White Wine

New Zealand

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough

90

Vibrant aromatics infuse the tropical fragrance of passion fruit and pineapples with basil and crushed tomato leaves. Long and succulent palate, combining exotic fruits with ripe, red capsicum and green olive. Crisp natural acidity.

Rosé Wine

Chile

Casillero Del Diablo Shiraz Rosé, Rapel Valley

35

Appealing aromas of fresh red fruits, particularly strawberries and raspberries. Very evident spicy notes, a variety-related trait.

USA

Gallo Family Vineyards White Zinfandel, California

35

Medium-bodied wine whose acidity is more dominant than sweetness. This wine showcases fruit flavors of dried cranberry with fresh cherry.

France

Whispering Angel, Château d'Esclans, Provence

65

One of the world's finest rosés. Aromas of cherries, and rose petals spill on to a lively palate of summer fruits including wild strawberries, white nectarine and quince.

Red Wine

Australia

Rothbury Estate Cabernet Merlot, New South Wales

30

Smoky blueberry and blackcurrant on the nose with a ripe palate showing flavours of cassis and hints of chocolate.

Germany

Weinhaus Röss Pinot Noir, Rheingau

35

Light-bodied, fragrant, full of sweet red fruit within a delicate structure, this is a delicious, moreish German Pinot Noir.

Italy

Cantine Leonardo Chianti DOCG, Tuscany

35

Clear, ruby-red in colour, with reasonable depth and 'legs' indicating good structure. Perfumes of cherries and fresh red fruit mingle with spicy, peppery notes. The wine is lively and fresh in the mouth, with soft, rounded tannins.

Chile

Casillero del Diablo, Carmenère, Rapel Valley

35

Soft and round, medium bodied, pleasant tannins, nice balance of sugar. A light fruity wine with the taste of dark chocolate, coffee and toast.

Argentina

Trivento Réserve Malbec, Mendoza

35

The nose is rich in spices, black berries plum and a touch of vanilla from the oak ageing. On the palate is dry, intense vigorous, with an intense tannic structure and nice slightly bitter aftertaste. Long and persistent. Full body.

Spain

Faustino VII, Bodegas Faustino, Rioja

38

Lively red with ochre hues. Well balanced nose, beautifully combined the vanilla from the oak and the fruitiness from the grape. In mouth it is velvety and elegant, intense and very persistent.

Red Wine

France

Château Merlet Cuvée “Les Collines Fleuries”, Bordeaux

40

This fresh, pleasant red wine appeals immediately by its bright cherry red colour with purple tints. On the nose, this Bordeaux offers plenty of finesse with peppery notes that give way to aromas of redcurrant and strawberry.

USA

Rancho Zabaco Zinfandel, California

40

This is a well structured wine, immediately approachable, offering spice and blackberry fruit that is both elegant and intense. Enticing flavours and aromas of ripe raspberry, black cherry and rich jammy fruit marries well with warm coconut and vanilla nuances.

New Zealand

Overstone Pinot Noir, Marlborough

40

Concentrated black cherry and dark berry aromas which follow through to the palate where dark berry fruit and cherry flavors are supported by soft tannins.

Australia

McWilliam’s Hanwood Estate Shiraz, South Eastern Australia

45

The wine is dry, not too acidic, not particularly tannic. General note of spice bringing touches of nutmeg and clove alternating with vanilla. Blackberry, black plum and raspberry hold up the fruit end of the equation.

Chile

Marques de Casa Concha Merlot, Rapel Valley

50

An impressive Merlot that showcases good structure and richness. From its dark and deep red colour the nose is muscular and delivers complex notes.

Red Wine

France

Michel Picard Pinot Noir, Bourgogne

55

Cherry red colour with purple tints. Concentrated and fruity – raspberry, cherry, black currant –, with a slight tinge of sweet spices. The structure includes a beautiful flexibility and moderate tannins. Final notes of red berries.

USA

William Hill Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, California

55

A small percentage of grapes are whole berry fermented, contributing softness in the tannin structure and an added richness, polished texture and body.

Italy

Rocca Sveva Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Veneto

60

Easy notes of spice and mature fruit with a distinctive note of almond nut. It delivers a lean, but firm mouthfeel with a light alcoholic push at the end.

South Africa

Diemersfontein Pinotage, Wellington

60

Dark chocolate with a hint of mint and baked plums on the nose. Ripe subtle tannins create a wine to be enjoyed young. This unique style of Pinotage is a perfect accompaniment to salmon, roast venison and dark chocolate mousse.

France

Michel Picard Mercurey 1^{er} Cru, Bourgogne

80

On the palate fresh and aromatic; the freshness of white fruits and flowers can be rediscovered.

Red Wine

Italy

Dal Forno Romano Valpolicella Superiore DOC, 2006,

200

Intense ruby red with orange reflections during the ageing. The nose is rich in fruit, especially cherry, blackberry and vanilla. In mouth is persistent and elegant, broadened by a weft of harmonious silky tannins.

Italy

Amarone Valpolicella DOC, 2006,

430

Complex and multi-layered, with aromas of dark and sour cherry, and wild red berry. Full-bodied with elegant layers of dried fruits, cherries, chocolate, and hazelnuts. Well-structured, full tannins and a delicious, long-lingering finish.

Spain

Vega Sicilia Ribera del Duero DO 'Unico' 2002,

450

This Unico is surprisingly ready to drink and offers a complex nose with layers upon layers opening up offering red berries, herbs, spice, dark fruits especially black current, tobacco and leather. When the wine enter the mouth it happens with a small but distinct explosion that reveals a full bodied harmonic wine.

Dessert Wine

France

Muscat de Saint-Jean-de-Minervois, Languedoc-Roussillon – ½ bottle

34

Deep yellow-gold in color with a gorgeous nose of apricot, lychee and floral notes. It is rich and full-bodied on the palate, with a long, seductive finish.
